Founded in 1996 by Dr Philip Nitschke - the first doctor in the world to provide legal, voluntary euthanasia, during the Rights of the Terminally Ill Act of the Northern Territory - Exit International provides members (average age 75 years) with accurate, concise information so that they may make their own end of life choices.

Formerly called the Voluntary Euthanasia Research Foundation, Exit international is headquartered in Darwin Australia and operates internationally.

Exit International Workshops

Exit International pioneered the concept of workshops to provide our members with information about their End of Life choices. Exit currently offers 2 types of workshops - Information and Advanced. Workshops are conducted regularly in all states of Australia, New Zealand and other countries.

Exit Information Workshops

Exit Information Workshops provide members with practical knowledge about a range of end of life issues including: the law, living wills, palliative care, depression and psychiatric illness and useful drugs as well as end of life devices such as Exit Bags and the use of Helium, Carbon Monoxide options, Useful Drugs and the Peaceful Pill. These workshops are free and open to all members of Exit.

Exit Advanced Workshops

Exit Advance Workshops provide members with the opportunity to develop their own end-of-life options. To date, a number of Exit members have created their own carbon monoxide generators (CoGenie). More recently, Exit members are working on the Peanut Project where each member creates for themselves a barbiturate-based drink; a Peaceful Pill.

Exit Clinics

Exit Clinics are information-based appointments for people who are too ill to attend Exit workshops. Clinic visits focus upon a range of medical issues and questions can be asked in a confidential and private environment and are available to members upon request.

Exit R&D

Exit International conducts a strong practical research and development program, making



findings available to members via Information Sheets and the *Deliverance* newsletter To date the Exit R&D program

has produced: The Deliverance Machine (laptop computer used during the Rights of the Terminally Ill Act - now in the British Science Museum - see above), Cargen (electrically heated carbon generator), Plastic Exit Bag with pressure monitor, homemade Peaceful Pill (alcohol and nicotine), barbiturate-based Peaceful Pill (under production).

Nancy's Friends Network

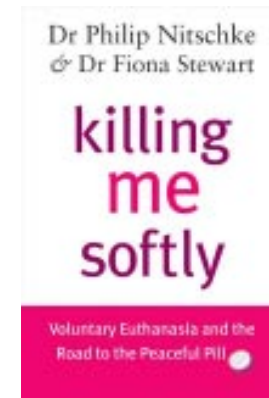
Nancy's Friends was established by Exit International in 2005 in memory of Exit member and VE activist, Nancy Crick. Nancy's Friends provides a national network of trained 'Friends' who are available to offer support and friendship to members concerned about their end-of-life options.

Deliverance Newsletter & News Service

The Deliverance newsletter is mailed to all Exit members monthly and provides comprehensive coverage of the Exit's activities, including workshops, research, media and politics. The Deliverance News Service (DNS) is a thrice weekly email newsletter that reproduces world news on VE.

Exit Books & Conferences

In 2005, Dr Philip Nitschke published his first book - *Killing Me Softly: Voluntary Euthanasia and the Road to the Peaceful Pill* with Dr Fiona Stewart (published by Penguin). Exit offers book and conference discounts to members.



Lapel Badges & Membership Cards

All members of Exit receive an Exit logo lapel badge and membership card which allows members to indicate Living Will status.
